

# 1st Course, 6th Class

## Wednesday, February 15

In this class we went much deeper into how we interpret planetary configurations in this class. Excellent questions from the students lead us into clarifying many points and understanding advanced concepts in Vibrational Astrology at only our 6th class. We are moving forward very nicely and relatively quickly in our understanding of Vibrational Astrology. Below are the class notes and the Chat area.

**1.** Homework: Similar to the previous weeks. There are a lot of videos. There are about 4 hours of videos to watch. The first 3 or 4 videos go over the basic planetary configurations, and the last videos look at complex and intricate planetary configurations.

Do not be concerned with all of the terminology in the last videos!!! These is terminology we are experimenting with to describe complex planetary configurations.

I recommend watching one video every day, or perhaps 2 videos in a day. Otherwise you might feel overwhelmed

with information.

We have the usual homework of writing a paragraph or two, or making a 5-minute to 10-minute video.

2. One of you looked for isotraps in your chart. Let's look at Harmonic Patterns Listing #1 for this.

3. Let's look at aspect and midpoint configurations related to the first 32 vibrations in your charts, to develop facility in **identifying** and **interpreting** the planetary configurations. Let's start with Kathy's 13V and 26V charts to understand that the 13V chart is telling you about 13V **and overtones of 13V**.
